Lets keep the good vibes rolling and look forward to more collaborations in the future. You guys are the heartbeat of *DCI*, and we can't wait to see what else we can create together!



a theme park and ride all the attractions without waiting in line and get all the snacks for free.


Explore abandoned places at night time to see if there's anything scary. Win every game of hide and seek by standing still in a corner.

Among the ruin in the night





900 Days: A Guide to Hifz

The human mind possesses many remarkable capabilities, and among them are the seldom used traits of determination and discipline. These qualities are the key to achieving anything, such as memorising the Quran. In this piece I will be discussing the basic principles of memorisation and how you can start. Firstly, I must describe the method used by the majority of people when it comes to hifz, called "rote learning". This is where one repetitively recites a verse over and over again to learn it. While undeniably effective, this method can often be unfortunately long and tedious and is only suitable for learning only a few lines at a time. This is why I have devised my very own method of memorisation named ARCTIC – Auditory learning, Repetition and recording, Comprehension, Time management, Intention, and Conservation. These simple steps are a tried and tested technique to hifz and helped me finish in exactly 900 days.

A - Auditory learning: This involves listening to a recitation of the verses you intend to learn repeatedly throughout the day, helping with subconscious memorisation and preventing pronunciation or rule mistakes. By listening to a reciter countless times, you are able to effectively hear the recitation in the back of your head whenever reciting, making this an effortless method of memorisation.



- **R Repetition and Recording**: This second step constitutes the bulk of memorisation as it is very closely related to rote learning. Start by reciting the verses by looking inside around ten times, and after extensive listening, you will find it surprisingly easy to memorise those verses through rote learning (repetition of verses). The most important part of this step is voice recording yourself reciting from memory and listening to that recitation, which can be done using a phone or recorder. This significantly increases the strength of the memorisation as it helps with prevention of mistakes.
- **C Comprehension**: In my opinion, this step is the simplest and most straightforward way to strengthen memorisation, yet it is neglected by 99 percent of everyone who does hifz. This step does not take longer than a few minutes and involves simply reading the translation of the verses once before and after memorising them. This allows one to grasp a general understanding of the meaning of the verses.
- **T Time management**: Utilising time efficiently is a very important factor to memorisation. If time is available, it is of utmost importance to take advantage of it. This can be done by dedicating certain times in the day or week to memorise. For example, most students find it easier to memorise in the morning, and some find it easier at night. Another thing that greatly helps is dedicating an entire weekend to just hifz (if possible and also if one is busy during the week), which can help one memorise an unimaginable amount of Quran due to the extra free time, which is crucial not to waste.
- I Intention: Also known as niyyah, this is the single most important aspect of hifz. It is a major sin to do hifz with the intention of doing it for worldly matters and not for the sake of Allah. It is reported by Muslim, at-Tirmidhi and an-Nasa'i that a man will come on the day of judgement having memorised the Quran, and he will be one of the first to be thrown into the fire for the sole reason of not doing it for the sake of Allah. As for the one who did hifz with the right intentions, they will be rewarded immensely.

C - Conservation: When one starts memorising, it is obligatory on them not to forget any of it, therefore conserving what they have becomes a priority to them. This simply means that one has to keep revising and revisiting what they have memorised in order to keep it fresh in their memory. This is often where most people struggle in hifz, mostly due to their quality of initial memorisation being weak or simply due to a lack of time. If one can stay consistent with their revision, then they have succeeded.

After having discussed this simple step method to memorisation, one must consider the time required every day to finish hifz. For instance, with consistent effort, memorising half a page daily could lead to completion in around five years, whereas learning a whole page daily could help one finish hifz in less than two and a half years. Bear in mind that the average time it takes to learn half a page is roughly 15 to 25 minutes, and one page can take from 30 to 45 minutes, so the idea of becoming a haliz is well able to be reached by anyone who can dedicate just a few minutes a day to learning.

To summarise, this self-developed "ARCTIC" method forms the fundamental foundation for efficient memorisation, engaging the senses and mind, as opposed to menial rote learning which solely relies on repetition to learn, whereas the above method relies on multiple factors such as listening, repetition and understanding. However, these are just the basics to hifz, and retaining it implores you to regularly revise what you have learned. That being said, the best time to start is right now, as highlighted by the verse: "And we have certainly made the Quran easy to remember, so is there any who will remember it?" (54:17).

Nabeel's STEM Project
